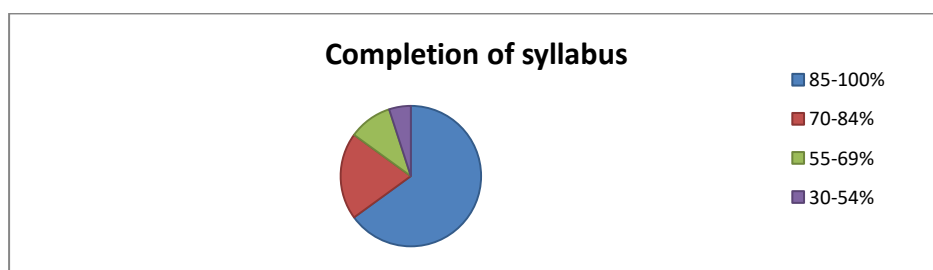


Table No.2 Table showing students opinion regarding teachers' preparation for class

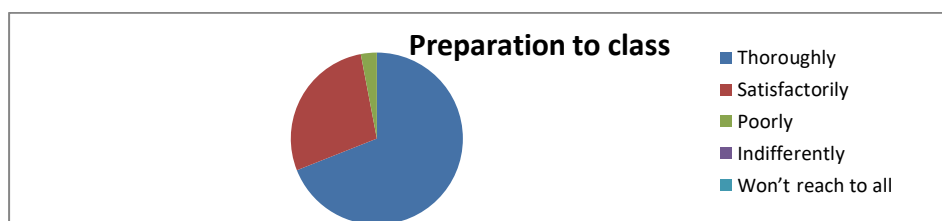


Table No.3 Table showing students opinion regarding teachers' communication

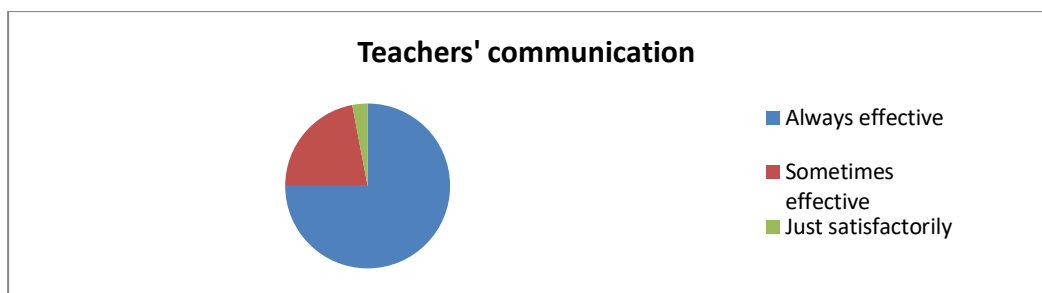


Table No.4 Table showing students opinion regarding teachers' approach to teaching

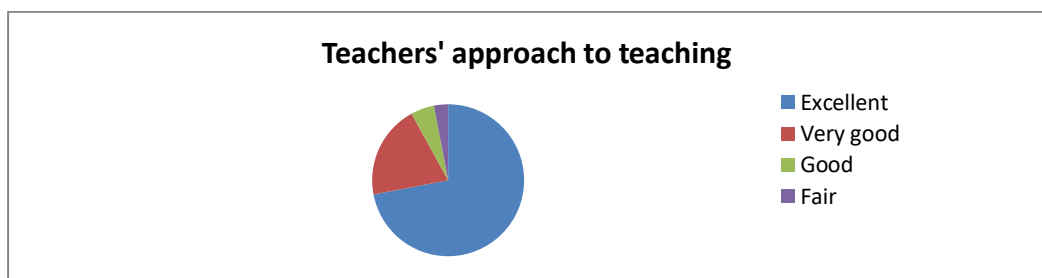


Table No.5 Table showing students opinion regarding fairness of internal evaluation process

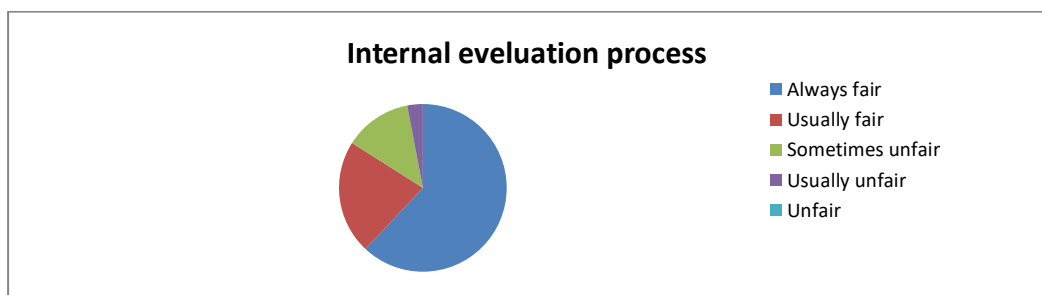


Table No.6 Table showing students opinion regarding their performance in assignment

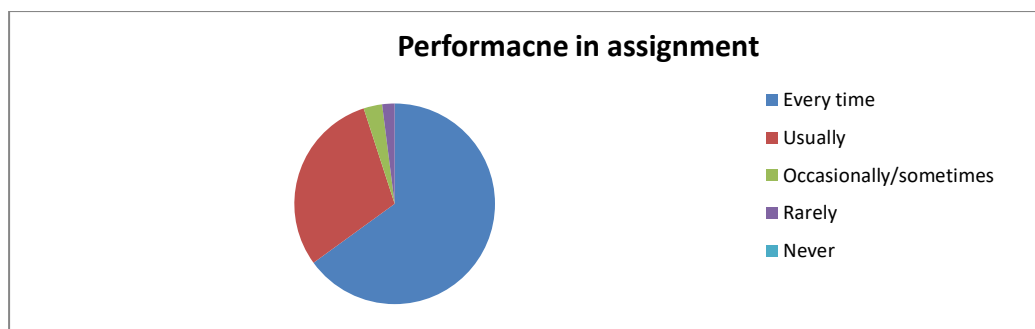


Table No.7 Table showing students opinion regarding teaching and mentoring process

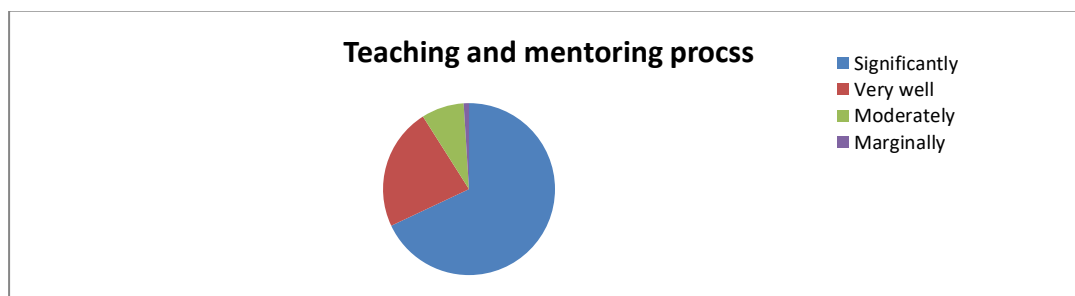


Table No.8 Table showing students opinion on overall growth opportunities provided by the institution

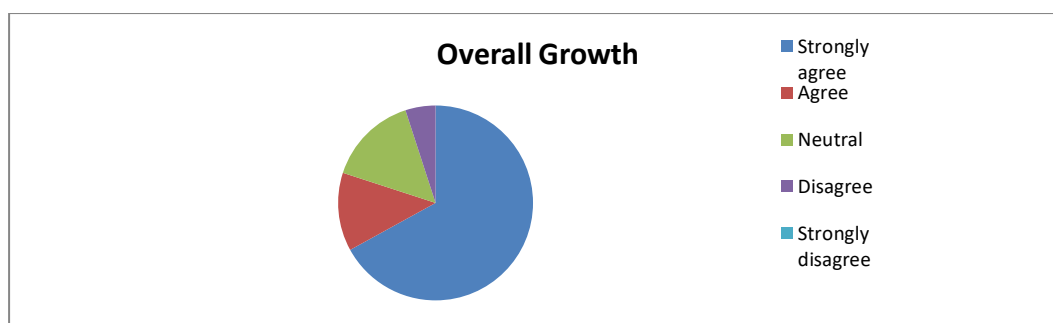


Table No.9 Table showing students opinion regarding teachers' information on Programme and course outcome

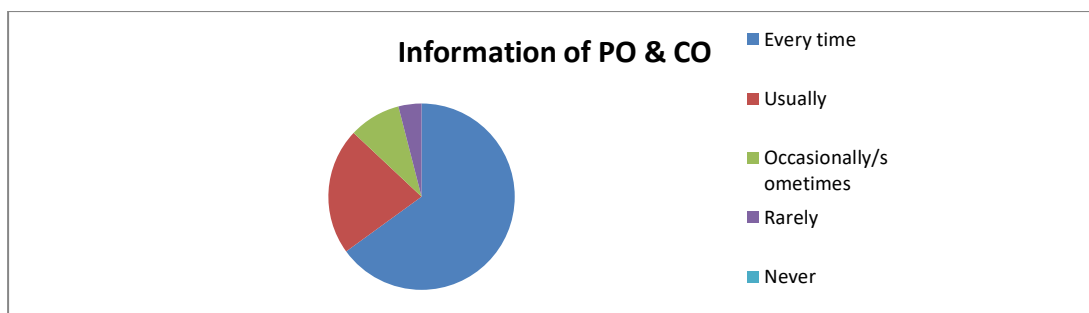


Table No.10 Table showing students opinion on mentor's follow-up

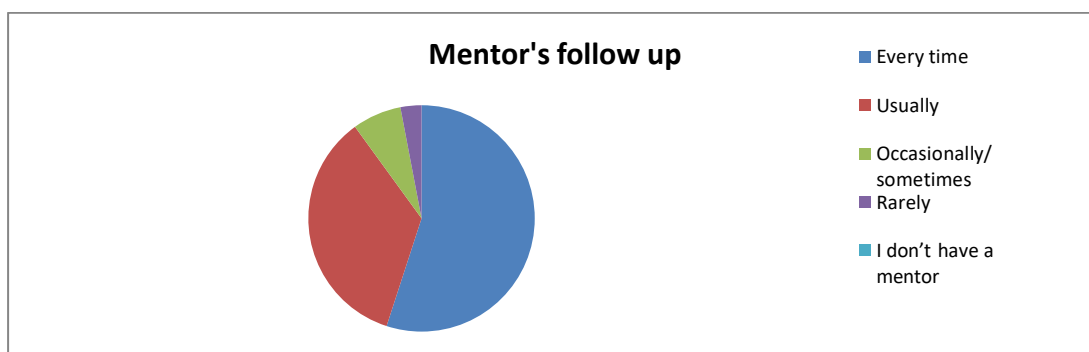


Table No.11 Table showing students opinion regarding teachers' illustrating the concept

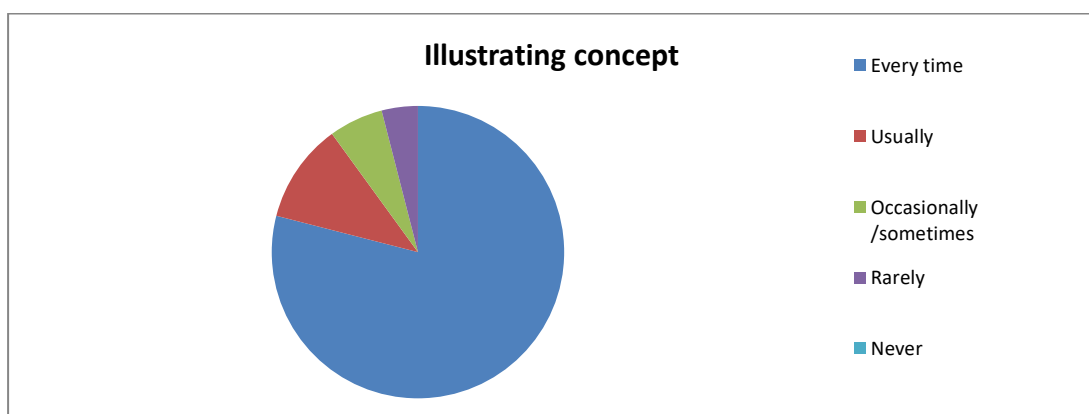


Table No.12 Table showing students opinion regarding teachers' identifying student strength and upliftment

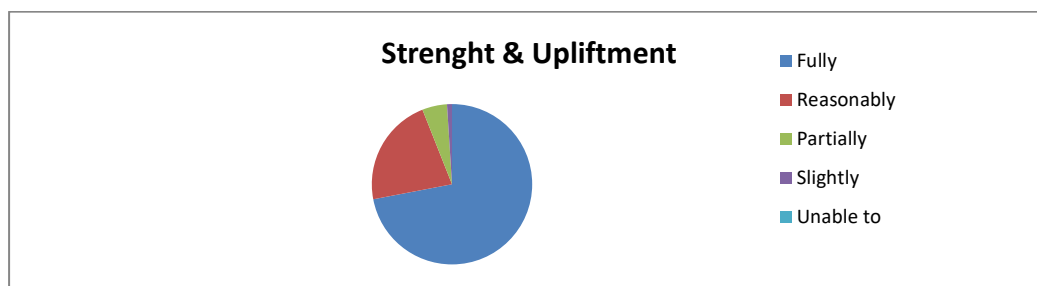


Table No.13 Table showing students opinion regarding teachers' identifying student weaknesses & overcome them

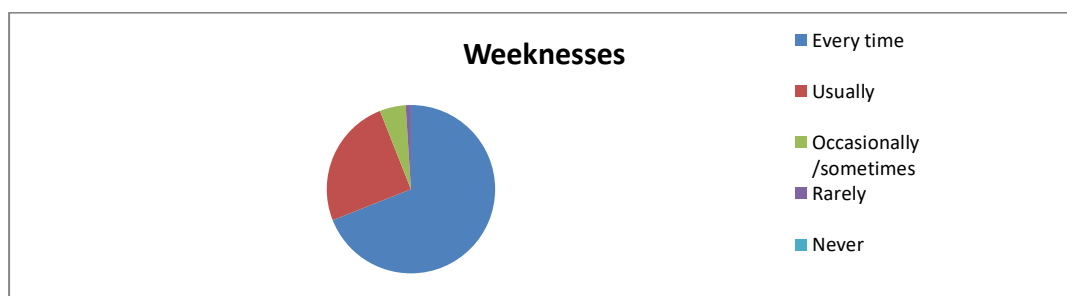


Table No.14 Table showing students opinion regarding institution effort in monitoring quality of teaching

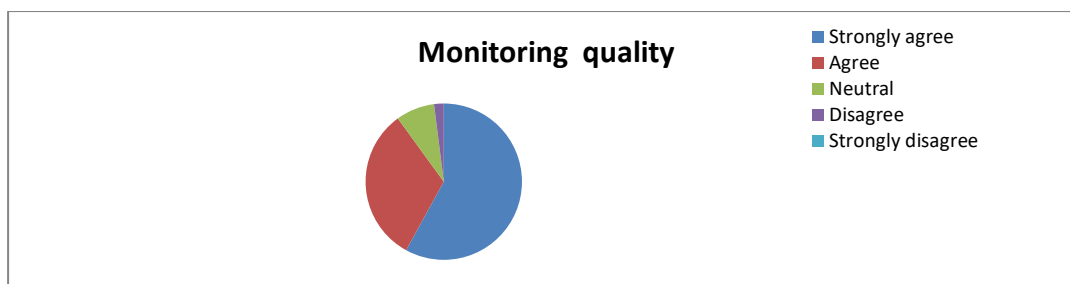


Table No.15 Table showing students opinion regarding teacher's use student centric methods such as experimental learning, participative learning and problem solving

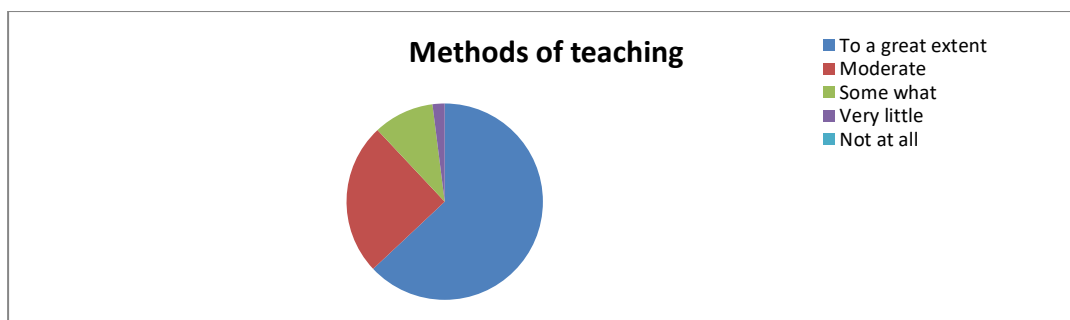


Table No.16 Table showing students opinion regarding teacher's encouragement to students to participate in extracurricular activities

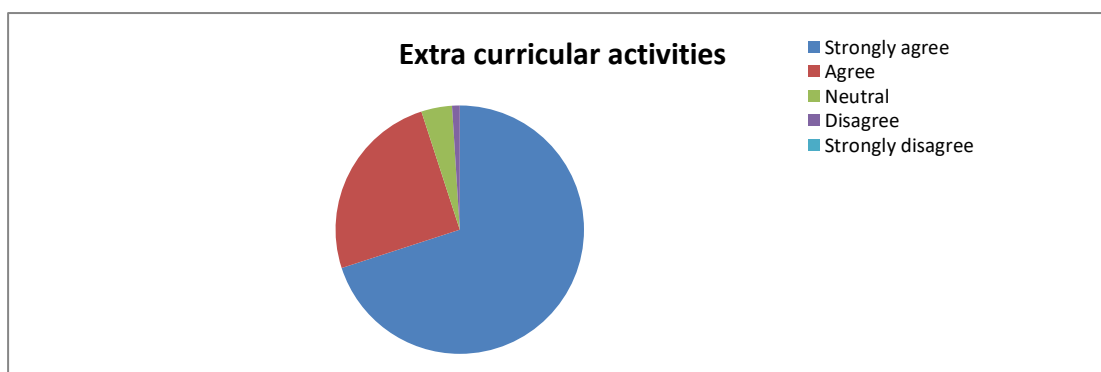


Table No.17 Table showing students opinion regarding teacher's efforts to inculcate soft skills and employability skills

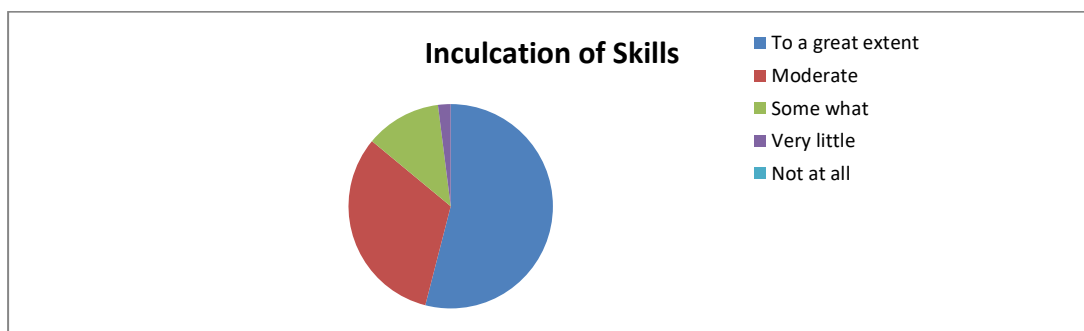


Table No.18 Table showing students opinion regarding percentage of teachers using ITC

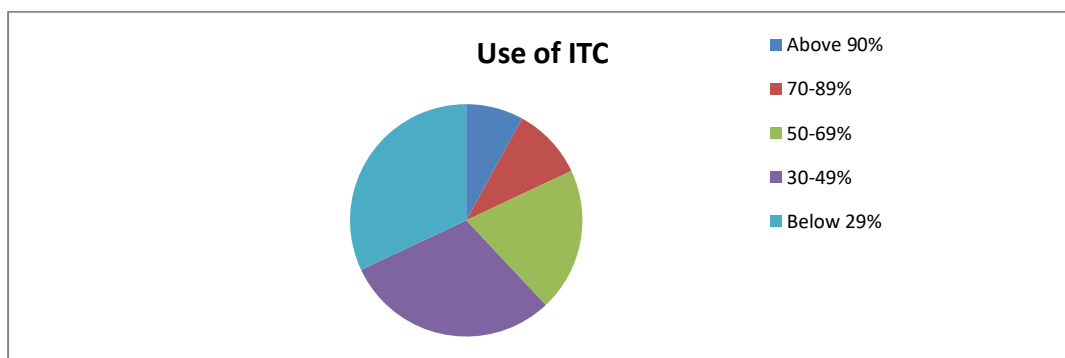
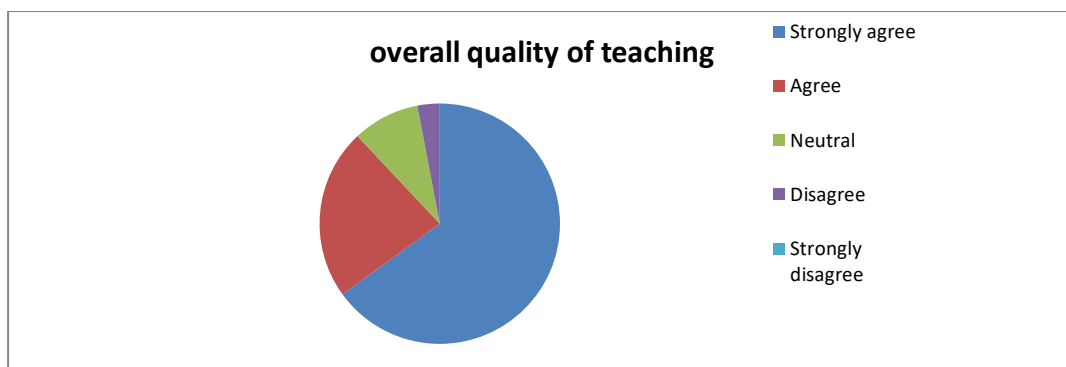


Table No.19 Table showing students opinion on overall quality of teaching and learning process is very good in the institution

Analysis:-

From the above tables it is found that

- 65% of the students are of the opinion that teachers complete 85-100% of the syllabus.
- 69% are of the opinion that teachers come to class with tough preparation.
- 75% students says that the teachers communication as always effective.
- 72% of the students are of the opinion that the teachers approach to teaching is excellent.
- Majority of the students expressed that teachers are always fair in internal evaluation.
- Majority of the students are of the opinion that teachers every time inform the performance of them in assignments.
- Majority of the students says that the teaching and mentoring process is significant and encourage for over all development of the students.
- Majority of the students are of the opinion that they have been everytime informed on programme and course outcome by the teachers and everytime the mentors follow up the students assigned to them.
